At Salone Satellite 2005 in Milan, young designers display their work hoping companies will buy, develop and distribute them for the commercial market. Innovative tactics range from developing new materials to recycling old ones.

Designs for Cultivate, by Sander Mulder and Dave Keune of Buro Vormkrijgers in the Netherlands, caught the eye. Therese (top left) is a breathtaking chandelier. It is made of PMM, a brand-new plastic substitute for glass, and has a fluorescent lamp of 14W. It measures 84cm x 94cm and weighs 15kg. www.cultivate.nl.

The Josephine floor lamp (left) is also made of transparent PMM and has a dimmable fluorescent 35W bulb. It measures 1,5m x 0,6m and weighs 10 kg. www.cultivate.nl.
